### Report on ToT for staff on 'living with pandemic with a particular focus on Covid - 19'

**Date** : 13-15 December 2020  
**Venue** : MKP Training center, Thakurgaon  
**Participants** : Female-07, Male-12

#### **Training objectives:**

- To know better about corona virus.
- To know about rumours and stigma..
- To know the relationship of human rights with the Corona situation.
- To know what needs to be done to protect human rights in the Corona situation.

#### **Description (Briefly):**

ToT for staff on 'living with pandemic with a particular focus on Covid - 19' was held on 13-15 December 2020 at MKP Training Center, Thakurgaon in collaboration with NETZ-Bangladesh and organized by Manab Kallyan Parished. A total of 19 employees of the project and the organization participated in the training. The entire training was conducted by Mr. Motahar Akand. Ms. Afsana Binte Amin, Program Manager of NETZ-Bangladesh was present at the inaugural ceremony of the training. In the inaugural talk, Ms. Afsana said, "We are currently going through a difficult time. At this time, people are facing more and more human rights violations, human dignity is being violated. As human rights activists, our main responsibility is to protect human rights. At the end of this training, if we, the nineteen participants, can protect the human rights of nineteen people that will be the success of this training. The training consisted of two-day sessions on five topics. The sessions are:

- Symptoms of Covid-19
- The impact of Covid-19
- Citizens deserve and the responsibility of the state to deal with Covid-19.
- What CSO members should and should not do to address Covid-19 and protect human dignity
- Citizens' rights on the basis of the UDHR and Constitution of Bangladesh to deal with Covid-19 through a neo normal life.

On the third day of the training, the participants divided into groups and practiced conducting the sessions. Through which the three-day training is completed. Ms. Afsana Binte Amin, Program Manager of NETZ-Bangladesh and Mr. Rabiul Azam, Director, MKP was present at the concluding ceremony of the training. In the concluding discussion, they said that in order to overcome the current difficult times, we have to work not only for health but also for the protection of human rights. We believe that people will be aware of their rights in the current situation if they can implement the lessons learned from the training at the field level.
