Objectives:

- To inform about the services of the organization.

Description (Briefly):

As part of the project's activities, the Union dialogue meeting held at union level from 1 to 29 October 2020 in 24 unions of Thakurgaon and Panchagarh districts while maintaining social distance. The dialogue meetings was held between Union agriculture standing committee and union CSO members by the chaired of Union CSO president. At first the representative of MKP presents the objective of the meeting. After that representative of Union agriculture standing committee members discussed their present service on detail. They say, their committees were formed but not effective. Even then, they are doing their utmost to improve the quality of agriculture services in the area. Then an open discussion was held. In the open discussion CSO members ask different question to the union agriculture standing committees members. The notable questions and suggestions were why are Mazra insects in paddy fields? Which fertilizer will be better in the potato field? Will all the farmers who cultivate other people's land get agricultural cards? What is the process of getting agricultural card? Are eligible people getting agricultural subsidy? At the farmer level, what method do you use to distribute agricultural machinery? What is the method of agricultural subsidy to given among farmers? Representatives of the Union agriculture standing committee members are answer the questions in detail. All the participants in the dialogue pledged to work together for the development of the agriculture sector in the area. Dialogue meetings are completed through spontaneous discussions.
